Act, 1998, I am directed to communicate the decision of the Academic Council taken in its meeting held on 18/06/2018. The Academic Council has unanimously resolved vide its resolution No. 39/2018 to grant continuation / Extension of affiliation to the Bachelor in Physiotherapy (BPTH) course of your college for the academic year 2018-19, subject to following conditions:
  - (a) The intake capacity shall be 40.
  - (b) As per grant of permission from Central Govt. / Central Council and / State Government (as applicable).

- The Dean / Principal of the College is hereby instructed to submit letter of permission from Central Govt. / Central Council and / State Government (as applicable) to the Admission Regulating Authority, Mumbai.
- In case of such irregular admissions, University shall not be responsible for any academic or pecuinary loss or damages of the concern.
- The admissions shall be done only through the Competent admitting Authorities.
